## specific responsibilities

## governance

- ❑ Modeled after the YWCA Board of Directors
- ❑ Executive, Program, Development, Conference Planning, and Nominating Committees
- ❑ Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary/Treasurer, Chair-Elect, Chief Operating Officer
- ❑ 40 total members, diversity critical, men included

# The Future Leaders Council

## membership requirements

- Attend 2 of 3 meetings in a fiscal year.
- Serve on a standing committee and attend 3 of the 4 meetings.
- Personally donate a minimum of \$250 and raise an additional \$750 each fiscal year.
- Attend racial justice training.
- Two year term renewed once.
