Register for this outdoor workshop and learn about the Waikalua Loko Fishpond; the science behind how fishponds operate; why fishponds were important to the native Hawaiian people; and what efforts are currently ongoing to restore these unique native Hawaiian cultural features.

### Directions to Waikalua Fishpond:

Take Kāneʻohe Bay Drive to Castle High School Performing Arts Center. At the traffic light, turn right onto Pūʻōhala Road (if you are coming from Kailua) or left if you are coming from Honolulu.

Take the first right onto Kulauli Street. Pass Pūʻōhala Elementary School and enter the golf course. Drive until you reach a fork in the road. Veer to the left and follow the signs down a dirt road to the end.

Parking is available at Waikalua Loko Fishpond.
