What is Candy Cane Corner?

Candy Cane Corner is a holiday store project that benefits individuals who are participating in programs at the YWCA Salt Lake City, The Road Home, or Volunteers of America Utah. It is a holiday gift shop that is staffed by volunteers and stocked with new unwrapped holiday gifts.

Who are the beneficiaries of the program?

Candy Cane Corner serves women, men and children participants in programs of the YWCA Salt Lake City, The Road Home, or Volunteers of America Utah.

Where and when is Candy Cane Corner held?

Candy Cane Corner will be held December 1 - 23, 2010. Donations can be delivered to our store which is located at 2526 South 300 West in Salt Lake City. The store is on the west side of the street with white letters on the building.

Do you accept money?

Yes, checks can be made out to the YWCA Salt Lake City, The Road Home, or Volunteers of America, Utah. Check or cash donations may be used to purchase items that may not be well stocked in the store.

Why was Candy Cane Corner created rather than just referring residents to existing programs?

The Candy Cane Corner holiday store creates an opportunity that is both empowering and dignified for individuals who may be experiencing a very difficult time in their lives, to select gifts for themselves and their children.

How can people help?
