

Riverside Art Battle
June 12, 2010
Artist Contract

Riverside Policies:

- Participants will bring their own supplies (paint, drawing implements, easel, canvas, etc.) A workspace will be provided for each artist. No advance preparation is allowed. If in doubt, consult coordinator. Artists will have their stations set up by 6:30pm. Event begins at 7:00pm. Competition will end at exactly 10:00pm. Any artist working outside these parameters will be disqualified.
- Artist may compete individually or as two person teams.
- Event Location: Studio 23-The Arts Center, 901 Water Street, Bay City, MI 48708.
- No spray paint, toxic or destructive materials are permitted indoors. Artist agrees the Riverside Art Festival has complete, absolute and final authority to disallow any materials, determine and interpret these rules, and to disqualify any Artist. The Riverside Art Festival specifically advises that this is an event open to the public and asks that participating avoid accidentally throwing paint or causing other such mishaps.
- Participation is limited to the first thirty Artists to enter by signing this contract and paying the entry fee.

Prize and judging:

- Winners, subject to the right of the Riverside Art Festival to disqualify, shall be determined by audience vote.
- Entrance fee for members of public, without exception for Artists guests, shall be \$15 per person.
- Each paid audience member shall be entitled to one vote to be cast by 10:30pm on the date of the event.
- At 10:30pm ballots shall be collected and tabulated by the Riverside Art Festival staff. The Riverside Art Festival reserves the right to manage any situation that arises, such as a conflict, alleged rule violation or tie, in a manner it chooses. Riverside Art Festival tabulation and determination is final. Winners will be announced immediately upon tabulation and cash prizes awarded to winners.
- Prizes are: first place \$500, second place \$150 and third place \$100

Payment:

An entry fee of \$25.00 must be paid at the time this contract is signed. No reimbursement shall be given by Riverside Art Festival for any reason.

Auction of pieces created:

Each Artist agrees his/her piece will be sold at auction on the night of the Riverside event. Riverside may elect to set a reserve price or not to sell a particular piece. Artist shall receive 50% of the actual auction proceeds for their piece.

Waiver and Indemnification:

Artist agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the Riverside Art Festival, YWCA of Bay County and Studio 23-The Arts Center for any claims resulting from Artist's act, omissions, or resulting from this Riverside Art Battle event.
