NAMES NEW CEO, BOARD MEMBERS**

Dana Campbell Saylor has been named CEO of the YWCA of Maricopa County. The announcement was made today by Board President Carolyn F. Bristo. Ms. Campbell Saylor assumed her duties on Monday, June 5, 2006.

We are confident we’ve made the correct choice,” said Ms. Bristo. “Ms. Campbell Saylor’s academic training, governmental, non-profit and business experience makes for a perfect “fit” for our needs. She’s not only well known, but also well regarded throughout the Valley of the Sun. We know she’ll lead the YWCA of Maricopa County into a bright future, building on the YWCA’s 92-year-history of service to our fellow citizens.”

In addition to the appointment of Ms. Campbell Saylor, four new Board Members have been named to the Board of Directors. They include: Christine French, American Express; Marci Hendrickson, Kitchell Construction; Nona M. Lee, Arizona Diamondbacks; and Jana Monroe, KPMG Forensics. The four Board members’ terms will officially begin July 1, 2006 and run for three years.

The YWCA of Maricopa County operates Thunderbirds/Haven House, a transitional shelter for previously homeless women and their children and provides a full array of services to senior citizens through its west valley facility, including noon meals at four different locations and the west valley’s only Home-delivered meals programs. The YWCA of Maricopa County hosts the annual Tribute to Women luncheon, which recognizes and honors ten outstanding
